Appointment Availability Standards – Primary Care Providers (PCP)

In accordance with Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) and Texas Department of Insurance (TDI), El Paso Health educates and monitors providers via surveys on Appointment Availability visits.

In the current months to come, HHSC will be conducting Secret Shopper Calls to Primary Care Providers (PCP) to measure the quality of services for the PCP standard.

It is imperative all standards are applied for Medicaid and CHIP Members in accessing care. Please make sure your staff is fully informed about the Appointment Availability standards and that these standards are being consistently met in your practice.

Primary Care Provider Appointment Availability standards:

| Emergency Care | Upon member presentation at delivery site/same day |
| Urgent Care | Within 24 hours; including urgent specialty care |
| Routine Primary Care | Within 14 calendar days of request |
| Referral for Specialty Care | Within 5 calendar days of request |

Preventative Health Care standards:

| Adults 21 years and older | Within 90 calendar days of request |
|------------------------------|------------------------------------|
| Newborn to less than 6 month | Within 14 calendar days of request |

| Children 6 months to 20 | Within 60 calendar days of request |
